- •Founded by Stig S. Bakken in 1999

- Avoiding code redundancy
- Packaged by functionality
- Object oriented
- •Flexible and extensible APIs

PEAR Packages

- Browsing by category
- Package homepage contains:
 - Summary, license, description, homepage
 - Maintainers
 - Download
 - Link to manual (optional)
 - Link to view all open bugs
 - Download statistics
 - Changelog for all releases



International PHP Conference 2004 Amsterdam

PEAR Manual

- Multiple languages (English*, French, Japanese, Hungarian, Dutch, Russian)
- *English is the primary language
- HTML (download and online), .chm
- DocBook based
- Currently also contains PECL docs
- We need more users contributing!

Bug tracking system

- http://pear.php.net/bugs
- Bug reporting
- Feature requests
- Patches (don't send patches to mailinglists)

PEPr

- PEAR Proposal System
- Package and RFC proposals
- Phases of a proposal:
 - draft
 - proposed
 - call for votes
 - finished
- Voting (open to all pear-dev members)
- Anyone can get a pear proposal account

- Manages the PEAR Manual
- Mailinglist: pear-doc@lists.php.net
- Users welcome (PHP manual was not mostly written by the actual developers!)
- Currently working on: using livedocs + WYSIWYG (or other alternatives to lower barrier to entry)

PEAR QA

- Quality Assurance team
- Mailinglist: pear-qa@lists.php.net
- PEAR QA RFC to be decided upon
- Help developers with QA issues
- Finds new maintainers for orphaned packages
- Building tools to make quality transparent
- Develops recommendations

PEAR Group

- PEAR steering committee
- Mailinglist: pear-group@php.net
- Handles outside relations
- Mediates on problems within PEAR
- Reserves a veto on all decisions, however does not have any real power beyond the trust the PEAR community has for them

Obtaining packages

- Easy to use installer
- Shipped with PHP since 4.3.0
- For lower versions:
 Easy to obtain installer through http://go-pear.org
- Different interfaces available:
 - CLI
 - Web
 - GTK

Development versions

- Latest development version in CVS
- Anonymous checkout possible cvs -d :pserver:cvsread@cvs.php.net:/repository login cvs -d :pserver:cvsread@cvs.php.net:/repository checkout pear
 - Password: phpfi
- CVS webinterface at http://cvs.php.net
