Almost 200 package maintainers, 500 developers

100% open source (PHP, Apache, BSD, LGPL license)

Standardization institution

Founded by Stig S. Bakken in 1999

Browsing by category Package homepage contains: Summary, license, description, homepage **Maintainers** Download links and statistics Link to manual (optional) and API docs Link to view all open bugs and report new bugs Changelog for all releases Dependencies



International PHP Conference 2004 Frankfurt

PEAR Manual

Multiple languages (English*, French, Japanese, Hungarian, Dutch, Russian)
*English is the primary language
HTML (download and online), .chm
DocBook based
Currently also contains PECL docs
We need more users contributing!

Mailinglist: pear-general@lists.php.net All other mailinglists and archives IRC channel on efnet: #pear Links resources: tutorials, forums etc No official forum (however external PEAR forums are very welcome!) PEAR logos :-)

PEAR Dev

Most PEAR package maintainers Mailinglist: pear-dev@lists.php.net All development discussion takes place here Non PEAR developers welcome, but not meant for user support (use pear-general@lists.php.net)

PEAR Doc

Manages the PEAR Manual

Mailinglist: pear-doc@lists.php.net

Users welcome (PHP manual was not mostly written by the actual developers!)

Most packages now have an entry in the manual

PEAR QA

Quality Assurance team Mailinglist: pear-qa@lists.php.net Help developers with QA issues Finds new maintainers for orphaned packages Building tools to make quality transparent Develops recommendations



International PHP Conference 2004 Frankfurt

PEAR Core

Develops the core PEAR infrastructure Mailinglist: pear-core@lists.php.net PEAR base class PEAR installer PEAR web



International PHP Conference 2004 Frankfurt

PEAR Webmaster

Manages pear.php.net Mailinglist: pear-sys@php.net (Servers), pear-webmaster@lists.php.net (Website) Contiously tweaking the site for better navigation and syndication (RSS)

PEAR Group

- PEAR steering committee
- Mailinglist: pear-group@php.net
- Handles outside relations
- Mediates on problems within PEAR
- Reserves a veto on all decisions, however does not have any real power beyond the trust the PEAR community has for them

Obtaining packages

- Easy to use installer
- Shipped with PHP since 4.3.0
- For lower versions:
 - Easy to obtain installer through http://go-pear.org
- Different interfaces available:
 - CLI
 - Web
 - GTK



International PHP Conference 2004 Frankfurt

Using the PEAR installer

Important PEAR Installer commands

- \$> pear [un]install [PackageName]
- \$> pear upgrade[-all] [PackageName]

Use **-f** option to force action

Instead of PackageName point to package.xml

or tar.gz in the filesystem or URL

- \$> pear list[-upgradeable]
- \$> pear config-show
- \$> pear config-set
- \$> pear package[-validate] [package.xml]

Development versions

Latest development version in CVS

Anonymous checkout possible

cvs -d :pserver:cvsread@cvs.php.net:/repository login cvs -d :pserver:cvsread@cvs.php.net:/repository checkout pear Password: phpfi

CVS webinterface at http://cvs.php.net

Flat package structure in CVS

Every package has its own directory

Used to better control code ownership

Startup with a package

Package structure: PEAR/ (php_dir setting) PEAR/docs/ (doc_dir setting) PEAR/docs/examples/ (doc_dir setting) PEAR/tests/ (test_dir setting) PEAR/data/ (data_dir setting) Find your settings with: \$> pear config-show Inside the package sources

PEAR Errorhandling

PEAR_Error Current standard Global error handler; overwrite locally PEAR_ErrorStack Flexible use of PEAR_Error, Exceptions Can be used for Warnings PEAR_Exception Based on native exceptions Adds nestable Exceptions, more context information, pretty output
